Jon Treasurer Report on 2018 Financials

Statement of Activity by Function

Housing at Philmont run through Escape, so earnings and expenses were inflated compared to 2017.

DPS/Major Luis Hernandez – Jon thanked the Maj Hernandez and the DPS for support of ESCAPE (2018 – \$3,901) which kept registration fees down.

Shrinkage in the size of teams has caused a decrease in membership in 2018 (2018 consisted of dues of \$1,815 for 2017 which were collected in 2018 and \$1,349 for 2018).

The council expended \$3,521 more for training than was collected in 2018. This was the result of failing to qualify for reimbursement of \$3500 by the DPS who will not reimburse until after a class is completed. In the future, instructors will be required to register with DPS to prevent the council from not being reimbursed. An anonymous donation by a council member was received to cover the shortfall.

Income Statement

Reported net revenue was \$6,943 in 2018 versus \$8,040 in 2017. After backing out 2 years of Escape activity in 2018 and 3 years of Escape activity in 2017, our earnings were \$2,585 in 2018 versus a loss of \$124 in 2017.

A change to a fiscal year that runs from Jul 1 to Jun 30 would better match our accounting cycle and preclude membership dues and Escape expenses running over 2 years.

Statement of Financial Position

Total assets were up \$6,943 to \$45,467 at year end 2018 compared to \$38,524 in 2017.
