Department of Public Safety

The State of New Mexico allocates funds annually which are specifically earmarked for SAR training. These funds generally support advanced DPS certification programs (Section Chief and Field Coordinator training), promote classes that support standards of SAR care (Lost Person Behavior), and this year are also helping to fund ESCAPE.

A portion of these funds may be allocated for team requested trainings at the discretion of DPS. This means that there is a budget for skill-specific training. Past examples have included man-tracking, land navigation and k9 air-scent seminars.





If your team has a specific training you'd like DPS here is what you need to know:

- The application can be found at, nmsarc.org/training and will be included in annual membership renewal packages.
- The fiscal year for training mirrors that of the state (July 1 – June 30)
- Ideally applications will be received Jan Feb prior to the FY for which they are requested with decisions make in March – April.


