# ESCAPE 2017 Proposal – Steve Sauer and Patricia Seiser

- Proposed site: Eddy County Fire Services Training Center, Carlsbad, NM
  - o 1400 Commerce Drive
  - Educational and training facility = ESCAPE could use free of charge
    - At least 9 classrooms (Website lists: 3 large classroom (50 capacity); 2 smaller classrooms (25 capacity); conference room (10-15); and large bay spaces (150-300))
    - All classrooms have wireless internet, AV equipment, whiteboards
    - On-site camping available for ~50 and RV park is 1.5 mi away
    - Airport is 5 min away and could handle helicopter landing
    - Debris pile and agility area for K9 training
    - Training towers
  - o Costs to NMSARC:
    - Shower trailer for campers
    - Catered lunch and dinner
  - Ouestions:
    - Unknown if alcohol restrictions exist on site
    - Unknown regarding liability insurance for attendees
  - Action Items:
    - Steve and Patricia will provide
      - 1. Details of the facilities, including photos
      - 2. Alcohol consumption rules
      - 3. AV support availability/cost,
      - 4. Site availability April 20-24 or April 27-30 (the Thursday is for setup)

- Ruidoso convention center was not available for our dates
- Las Cruces convention center possibility
  - o Available late March or early May
  - o Lunch \$20; dinner \$25
  - o 2 ballrooms; 6 classrooms, \$14-18K; exhibit hall adds \$2K
- Ruidoso Bonita Park may lack adequate facilities
- Any LEA or National Guard facility are available to us per RO
- Rio Rancho facility would be inadequate
- Carlsbad
  - o Help reduce registration cost
  - o More distant/remote
