NMSAR Forum Usage Guidelines Approved by NMSARC Board - February 27, 2017

Purpose of the NMSAR Forum

This forum is intended to provide a venue for discussion of topics of interest to the New Mexico Search and Rescue community.

Forum Membership

Any member of a New Mexico Search and Rescue Council Team is eligible to join. Other individuals with close ties to New Mexico Search and Rescue may request membership. These join requests will be considered on a case-by-case basis.

Rules of the Road

- 1. All posts must relate directly to search and rescue.
- 2. Use a clear and descriptive subject line for your post.
- 3. Post about one topic at a time.
- 4. Do not post replies that do not add value.
- 5. Stay on topic. If you have a suggestion or comment that is on a different topic, please start a new thread.
- 6. Be civil. Posts that are deliberately hostile or insulting to other members of the NMSAR Forum community will be removed and a warning sent to the posting party.
- 7. Do not advertise. You may post information about a product or service (e.g., fee-based training) that is related to search and rescue.
- 8. Do not solicit personal information.
- 9. Include your name in all posts. Including your team affiliation is also recommended.
- 10. If you are unsure whether your post fits these guidelines, please send your request to admin@nmsar.org.

The New Mexico Search and Rescue Council Board reserves the right to determine whether a message is inappropriate and to take action as noted in the **Inappropriate Use** section.

Inappropriate Use

- 1. A post that violates the **Rules of the Road** above may be removed by the Forum editors (upon the recommendation of at least 3 members of the NMSARC Board) and the person posting will be issued a warning.
- 2. A second violation will result in permanent revocation of the individual's Forum privileges.
